# INTERACTIONS WITH THIS MEDICATION

- Do not use this product if you are taking:

   Daily low dose ASA (81 325 mg), without taking to a doctor or pharmacist, bluprofen may interfere with the preventive benefits of ASA

# PROPER USE OF THIS MEDICATION

Usual dose:
Adults and children 12 years and over: Take 1 (every 4 hours) or 2 (every 6 to 8 hours) captels as needed. Do not exceed 6 captels in 24 hours, unless directed by a physician. Do not use honger than 3 days for a fever or 5 days for pain reflef. Children under 15 should use Ohldren's Advil.

### Overdose:

In case of overdose, contact a Poison Control Centre or doctor immediately, even if there are no symptoms.

Missed Dose:
Take the missed dose as soon as you remember, if it is almost time for your next, dose, wait until then to take your medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take two doses at the same time.

## SIDE EFFECTS AND WHAT TO DO ABOUT THEM

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Take with food or milk if upset storage hocurs, if abdominal pain, hearthum, nausea or womlting, bleating, distribes or constigution, ringing or buzzing in the ears, nervousness, seedpessness, distripes or any change in vision, intribun, taked retention, shortness of breath, wheezing, any trouble breathing or chest tightness, bees, switching or inchine, side reads see, skin redenting, listens; blood in own; the body or labeck sloods, journalce yellowing of the eyes or skin due to here problems, or any other side effect or userglained symptoms develop while taking And, discontinue use immediately and contact a physician.
