   take other drugs containing prescription or
  nonprescription NSAIDs [aspirin, ibuprofen,
  naproxen, or others]
   have 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while
  using this product
   take more or for a longer time than directed
  Heart attack and stroke warning: NSAIDs, except
  aspirin, increase the risk of heart attack, heart failure,
  and stroke. These can be fatal. The risk is higher if you

#### Do not use

- Do not use

  in children under 12 years of age
  if you have ever had an allergic reaction to any other pain reliever/fever reducer
  right before or after heart surgery
  if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric, or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or for 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI drug. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI, ask a doctor or pharmacist before taking this product.

  Ask a doctor before use if

  you have a breathing problem such as emphysem or chronic bronchitis

  stomach bleeding warning applies to you

  you have problems or serious side effects from taking pain relievers or fever reducers

  you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn
  you have high blood pressure beart dispanded.
- Byou have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, kidney disease, asthma, thyroid disease, diabetes, glaucoma, trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland, or had a
- stroke you are taking a diuretic

#### Drug Facts (continued)

### Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are

- under a doctor's care for any serious condition taking sedatives or tranquilizers
- taking any other product that contains pseudoephedrine, chlorpheniramine or any oth nasal decongestant or antihistamine taking aspirin for heart attack or stroke, becaus ibuprofen may decrease this benefit of aspirin taking any other drug

- When using this product
   take with food or milk if stomach upset occurs
   avoid alcoholic drinks
   be careful when driving a motor vehicle or
- operating machinery
- drowsine
- drowsiness may occur alcohol, sedatives, and tranquilizers may increase

#### Stop use and ask a doctor if

- you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding:

- slurred speech leg swelling

- lever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
  nasal congestion lasts for more than 7 days
  redness or swelling is present in the painfu
  you get nervous, dizzy, or sleepless
  symptoms continue or get worse
  any new symptoms appear

any new symptoms appear if pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use ibuprofen at 20 weeks or later in pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the nborn child or complications during delivery.

Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

#### Directions

- do not take more than directed
   the smallest effective dose should be used
   adults: take 1 caplet every 4-6 hours while
- symptoms persist
  do not take more than 6 caplets in any 24-hour period, unless directed by a doctor children under 12 years of age: do not use

- Keep carton. store at 20-25°C (68-77°F)
- avoid excessive heat above 40°C (104°F)
