

## Drug Facts

### Active ingredients

Potassium nitrate 5% .....Antihypersensitivity  
Sodium fluoride 0.25% (0.15% w/v fluoride ion) .....Anticavity

### Purposes

### Uses

- builds increasing protection against painful sensitivity of the teeth to cold, heat, acids, sweets, or contact.
- aids in the prevention of dental cavities.

### Warnings

#### Stop use and ask a dentist if

- the problem persists or worsens. Sensitive teeth may indicate a serious problem that may need prompt care by a dentist.
- pain/sensitivity still persists after 4 weeks of use.

**Keep out of reach of children.** If more than used for brushing is accidentally swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.



## Drug Facts (continued)

### Directions

- **adults and children 12 years of age and older:**
  - apply at least a 1-inch strip of the product onto a soft bristle toothbrush.
  - brush teeth thoroughly for at least 1 minute twice a day (morning and evening), and not more than 3 times a day, or as recommended by a dentist or doctor. Make sure to brush all sensitive areas of the teeth. Minimize swallowing. Spit out after brushing.
- **children under 12 years of age:** Consult a dentist or doctor.

### Other information

- do not store above 25°C (77°F)

water, sorbitol, hydrated silica, glycerin, PEG-8, sodium lactate, flavor, cocamidopropyl betaine, titanium dioxide, xanthan gum, sodium saccharin, PVM/MA copolymer, sodium hydroxide
