

Drug Facts

Active ingredients

Potassium nitrate 5%.....Antihypersensitivity
Sodium fluoride 0.24% (0.15% w/v fluoride ion).....Anticavity

Purposes

Uses

- builds increasing protection against painful sensitivity of the teeth to cold, heat, acids, sweets, or contact.
- aids in the prevention of dental cavities.

Warnings

Stop use and ask a dentist if

- the problem persists or worsens. Sensitive teeth may indicate ►

Drug Facts (continued)

- a serious problem that may need prompt care by a dentist.
- pain/sensitivity still persists after 4 weeks of use.

Keep out of reach of children. If more than used for brushing is accidentally swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

Directions

- **adults and children 12 years of age and older:**
 - apply at least a 1-inch strip of the product onto a soft bristle toothbrush.
 - brush teeth thoroughly for at least 1 minute twice a day (morning and evening), and not more than 3 times a day, or as recommended by a ▼

Drug Facts (continued)

- dentist or doctor. Make sure to brush all sensitive areas of the teeth. Minimize swallowing. Spit out after brushing.
- **children under 12 years of age:** Consult a dentist or doctor.

Other information

- do not store above 30°C (86°F) ►

Inactive ingredients water, hydrated silica, sorbitol, glycerin, pentasodium triphosphate, PEG-8, flavor, titanium dioxide, cocamidopropyl betaine, sodium methyl cocoyl taurate, xanthan gum, sodium hydroxide, sodium saccharin, sucralose
